Good Morning,

The deadline is approaching for businesses and non-profit organization to apply for the Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) in North Carolina impacted by the Severe Storms and Flash Flooding in North Carolina that occurred on May 8, 2024, the deadline is approaching to apply for working capital disaster loans. Apply for EIDL loans by February 24, 2025, deadline.

The declaration includes the counties of: Gaston County, Cleveland, Lincoln, and Mecklenburg; and the contiguous South Carolina County of: York. These federal [Economic Injury Disaster Loans \(EIDLs\)](#) are for working capital needs caused by the disaster and are available even if the business did not suffer any physical damage.

Businesses of all sizes and private nonprofit organizations may borrow up to \$2 million to repair or replace damaged or destroyed real estate, machinery and equipment, inventory, and other business assets.

Applicants may apply online and receive additional disaster assistance information at [sba.gov/disaster](https://sba.gov/disaster).
