Growing up in the 70s and 80s, Bunny Gregory realized there weren't any venues for black artists to express themselves in Charlotte. Because of her love for hip hop and pop art, she opened her own venue, the UNDERGROUND, in 2014, which quickly became a staple platform for Charlotte-based urban artists, musicians, and poets. In 2017, Bunny was dubbed "Queen Mother of Charlotte's Underground Hip Hop" by Creative Loafing Magazine. Bunny has recently launched a "Harlem Renaissance" on wheels. This UNDERGROUND Mobile Art Studio and Gallery for young artists serves low-income youth in West Charlotte where she grew up.
