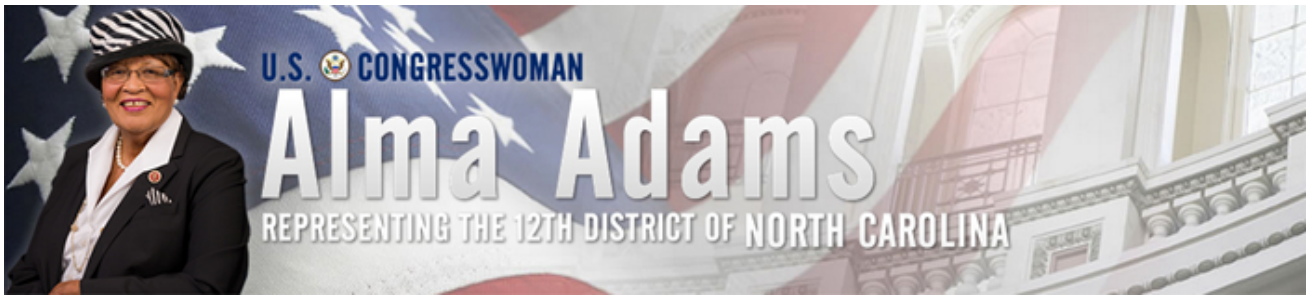


Happy Labor Day from Congresswoman Alma Adams

As a member of the Committee on the Education and the Workforce (E&W) I am determined to fight for *all* workers, however they work, pray, look, or live their lives.

As the Ranking Member of the E&W Subcommittee on Workforce Protections, I am particularly passionate about worker safety.



Pictures from my visit to Trane Technologies in August, where they recently marked three million working hours, over 10 years, without a safety incident.

One such example of this was my introduction last year of the **Asunción Valdivia Heat Illness, Injury and Fatality Prevention Act**, with my fellow colleagues **Rep. Judy Chu (CA-28)**, **E&W Ranking Member Rep. Robert C. "Bobby" Scott (VA-03)**, **Rep. Raul Grijalva (AZ-07)**, **Senator Alex Padilla (D-CA)**, and **Senator Sherrod Brown (D-OH)**.

I was very pleased this July, when the Biden-Harris Administration put many of these proposed rules into place through the US Department of Labor, using existing legislation on the books to correctly identify overheating as a common workplace hazard. Workers who grow, pick, and process our food will be safer for it, as will many more working-class people trying to make a living. Lives will be saved. Legislation like this is how we honor labor, this Labor Day and always.

For all those who labor, know that I will never stop fighting for you.
