Rapid Response To Hurricane Helene

SOL Nation partners with Cornerstone Summit Church to establish supply hubs in Boone and Charlotte, NC after Hurricane Helene devastates the northwestern NC.



Hurricane Helene significantly impacted Boone, NC, causing severe flooding that disrupted daily life and local infrastructure. Many residents were forced to evacuate as floodwaters inundated homes and businesses, leaving behind substantial damage. Emergency services worked tirelessly to rescue stranded individuals and provide temporary shelters. Power outages and road closures complicated recovery efforts, while local authorities implemented measures like curfews and boil water advisories to ensure public safety. The storm highlighted Boone's vulnerability to extreme weather, emphasizing the need for long-term resilience planning.



Pastor Reggie Hunt of Cornerstone Summit Church reached out to SOL Nation, asking for our help in creating a hub where residents can receive aid and relief supplies to ease the pain of losing their homes. For several days, our Executive Director, Tiffany Fant, worked tirelessly, training and supporting the teams in Boone. 
