## Clerk's Office Seeks to Fill District 4 Vacancies on County's Information Services & Technology Committee

The County is seeking applicants to fill vacancies on the Information Services & Technology Committee (ISTC). ISTC serves as an advisory group to the Board of County Commissioners and reviews plans, at a conceptual level, for major new automated systems. The committee reviews the justification of a system and the adequacy of system functions, along with the availability of technology and personnel resources. Members are expected to have expertise in managing information systems and will provide feedback to the Board, when necessary, on information technology challenges.
