Diorio will present her recommended budget for Fiscal Year 2026 to the Board of County Commissioners on Wednesday, May 14, at 11 a.m. The presentation will take place in the meeting chamber of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center, located at 600 East Fourth Street, in Charlotte.

The County Manager will outline her funding recommendations for County operations, services, and recommendations to support the Board's established priority areas.
