In addition, members hear appeals and reach decisions on service charges, credits, and adjustments. In particular, the SWAC is looking to fill its financial, accounting, or legal profession vacancies.

## Department of Community Resources Awards \$4.2 Million in Heating and Cooling Assistance to Residents

The County's Department of Community Resources helped more than 11,226 residents receive funds through the [Low-Income Energy Assistance Program](#) (LIEAP). LIEAP is a federal program that aims to assist households with their home heating needs during the winter months. More than 17,000 people applied for this season's program, a 21% increase from last season, resulting in over \$4.2 million in assistance being awarded from Dec. 1, 2024, to March 31, 2025.
