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Clerk's Office Needs Volunteers for Park and Recreation Commission

The County [Clerk's Office](#) is encouraging residents residing in the 28202 ZIP code to apply for vacancies on the commission that serves as the recreation advisory body for the Mecklenburg [Board of County Commissioners](#) (BOCC). Applicants can utilize the [PRC District Nominee Addressing](#) tool to review their qualifications.

The commission is responsible for proposing recreation regulations, which in its judgment are necessary to support and protect the assigned responsibilities as defined in its resolution. In addition, members are tasked with advising the BOCC in all matters affecting recreation programs, and the acquisition and disposal of lands and properties related to all aspects of the County's recreation program.

Individuals interested in serving are asked to [submit an application online](#) or contact the County Clerk's Office, at 980-314-2939, or Clerk@MeckNC.gov. Applicants must reside in Mecklenburg County to qualify for an appointment.

The services are part of the implementation of Mecklenburg County's [Behavioral Health Strategic Plan](#), which was published in 2024 following engagement with providers, stakeholders, partners, and community members dedicated to improving mental health care.
