Clerk's Office Seeks Applicants to Fill Vacancies on the Region F Aging Advisory Committee

The [Region F Aging Advisory Committee](#) was established by legislative authority to assist the [Centralina Area Agency on Aging](#) staff to provide direction for programming and services for the population over sixty. The Committee consists of representatives from Anson, Cabarrus, Gaston, Iredell, Lincoln, Mecklenburg, Rowan, Stanly and Union Counties.

Members are charged with developing and administering the established area plan, conducting public hearings when necessary, representing the interest of older persons, as well as reviewing and commenting on all community policies, programs and actions which affect older persons.

Established in 1972, the award is given by the Board of County Commissioners to those who have shown exceptional bravery or high level of service to the people of Mecklenburg County.

Diorio, the first woman to serve as Mecklenburg County manager, will be honored with the Order of the Hornet award for the more than 18 years of unyielding commitment and service she dedicated to Mecklenburg County and its residents.

County Solid Waste Division Opens New Materials Recovery Facility

Mecklenburg County Solid Waste will hold a grand opening on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, for its new Pence Road Materials Recovery Facility (MRF). The 48,510 square foot facility at 7833 Pence Road provides the County flexibility in managing sustainable resources and keeping more items out of local landfills.

The Pence MRF processing hub will be utilized for all single stream recyclable materials collected from residential curbside programs, schools, and drop-off programs throughout the County and several surrounding areas. This facility will be Mecklenburg County's main processing center while the County undertakes a major retrofit of its flagship Metrolina MRF on Amble Drive. Once opened the facility will be able to process more than 300 tons of recyclables a day. To learn more about the County's recycling and disposal centers visit Wipeoutwaste.MeckNC.gov.
