Clerk's Office Encourages Residents to Apply for Juvenile Crime Prevention Council Advisory Board

The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council ([JCPC](#)) is a statutorily authorized County advisory board charged with reviewing the needs of juveniles who are delinquent or at risk of becoming court involved. In particular, the Clerk is searching for representatives to fill vacancies for the following slots: Juvenile Defense Attorney (JDA), Business Community Member, Youth (Under the age of 21), and Substance Abuse Professional.

JCPC's ongoing mission is to address the gaps in youth services by promoting prevention, intervention, treatment, and aftercare strategies and programs that strengthen families and support community safety. Members can serve up to two two-year terms.

Meck Pre-K Reaches Record Enrollment for Upcoming 2025-2026 School Year

MECK Pre-K, a high-quality, free pre-kindergarten program open to all four-year-old children in Mecklenburg County recently reached a significant milestone, since its establishment in 2018. For the upcoming school year, the Program has already received over 1,800 registrants, a record number for this time of year. Last year the Program graduated 1,755 children in June of 2025.
