The purpose of the Lake Norman Marine Commission is to promote coordinated governance, resource protection, and responsible public use of Lake Norman in collaboration with Catawba, Iredell, Lincoln, and Mecklenburg County. The participating counties have the power to meet jointly in passing regulations or make regulations through designated representatives on the Commission.
