Join us on Wednesday, Sept. 24, 2025, from 6-7 p.m. for the next NCDHHS Fireside Chat & Tele-town Hall: NC Medicaid: Strengthening the Health of 1 in 4 North Carolinians. The virtual town hall will stream live across NCDHHS social media channels and through a phone line.

We are approaching the second anniversary of Medicaid expansion, which launched on Dec. 1, 2023. Since then, almost 700,000 newly eligible North Carolinians have enrolled and now have access to full health coverage through Medicaid. Today, **1 in 4 people** in North Carolina have Medicaid, which provides affordable health coverage, access to doctors and prescriptions for more than **3 million** children, older adults, people with disabilities, veterans and working North Carolinians.
