Nearly **24 million people** rely on individual insurance purchased with the help of the Affordable Care Act's Enhanced Premium Tax Credits. Those credits are on the chopping block. If Congress fails to extend these credits:

- Nearly **4 million people** could lose their healthcare coverage entirely.
- More than **20 million people** could see premiums increase by an average of 75–100%.

Families who pay for their healthcare coverage cannot afford this burden. The consequences are real, immediate, and devastating.
