**CHARLOTTE, NC**—Today, **Congresswoman Alma S. Adams, Ph.D. (NC-12)** released a statement on the request by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Fraternal Order of Police to deploy the National Guard in Charlotte.

“I strongly believe deploying the National Guard in Charlotte as requested by the Fraternal Order of Police is unnecessary. Consistent public safety improvements in Charlotte by the Mayor and City Council have led to a significant reduction in violent crime and homicides in 2025. I am confident that Mayor Lyles’ and the Charlotte City Council’s work with Governor Stein and the White House to meet all security and safety standards for the city is appropriate and underway, and I support their collaborative efforts to provide for public safety in Charlotte.”
