In August, NAACP sued Texas following the passage of a new electoral map to strip Black people of their voting power.

Just yesterday, the North Carolina Senate passed a Trump-directed gerrymandered voting map aimed at dismantling one of the state's Black districts.

Now, the Supreme Court is poised to erase one of the last tools available to protect the right to vote for Black people and other historically disenfranchised Americans.

And that's what President Trump wants. Because his extremist agenda is so unpopular, he can't fairly win another majority in Congress.

The health of our democracy depends on both a functioning government and a fair one.
