Hi everyone,

I hope you're doing well and staying safe. I'm writing with several important updates that directly impact Mecklenburg County and communities across our state. These issues affect healthcare access, public safety, and the wellbeing of thousands of North Carolinians, and I want to make sure you have the most accurate information.

Public Safety Update: Possible Border Patrol Deployment as Soon as Saturday

Over the past several days, reports have circulated about a potential federal immigration enforcement operation in Charlotte, with activity possibly beginning as soon as Saturday. These reports have understandably created fear and confusion for many families, especially among our immigrant neighbors.

While federal agencies control these operations, not local or state government, what concerns me is that we still have not received any clear or direct communication from the federal government about what is being planned, what the scope is, or how long it may last.

Even in situations where federal agencies act independently, transparency matters. Local officials, community organizations, and law enforcement partners need information to ensure residents are safe, informed, and supported. At this point, that clarity simply has not been provided.

In response to this uncertainty, I joined a coalition of local and state leaders in issuing a joint statement to speak directly to our immigrant neighbors. Our intent was twofold:

1. To reassure families that they are not alone, and that Charlotte is a place where everyone belongs; and
2. To share accurate information about what local agencies, including
