The deadline for all residential contracts to be signed is Dec. 31, and the deadline for commercial and nonprofit contracts is March 31, so prospective purchasers will still have plenty of time to evaluate their proposal before making a final decision.

The price of all residential solar energy systems sized over 5kW has been lowered to \$1.95 per watt, which is over 30% lower than the initial offering from the campaign.
