December 2025 Update

Progress continues on the [Uptown CycleLink](#) (UCL), an approximately 7-mile-long network of separated bike lanes that, once complete, will connect more than 40 miles of bikeways into and across center city Charlotte.

[The Belk Greenway Connector](#) project is currently in the real estate acquisition phase, which is expected to be finished by the end of the year. The project team is working on 100% design plans, which must be approved by the North Carolina Department of Transportation before the bid phase can start. Construction is expected to start in the fall of 2027 and be complete in the summer of 2028.

The project team has created a presentation to educate residents about the overall purpose of the project, where it's located, next steps and a schedule for completion.
